WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR FROM EACH CHILD AUDITIONING?

- Know the name of the song and part they're auditioning for **BY MEMORY** – for example, “Ms. Tamre, I’m going to sing the first solo in “The Fruit of the Spirit.”
- Be prepared to read or sing other scriptures/solos
- Show us that you can make eye contact, let some personality shine through while singing or speaking and that you can match pitch.
- An understanding that due to the large number of kids who audition, not every child will receive a part.

IF CHOSEN, CHILDREN MUST COMMIT TO:

- Attend 2 extra rehearsals on Wednesdays between March 4th and April 15th. These rehearsals will be a 10-minute time slot between 4 and 5:30 p.m.
- Attend the **REQUIRED** Tech Rehearsal on Monday, April 27th at 3:45 pm.
- Attend the **REQUIRED** Dress Rehearsal on Monday, April 27th at 5:45-7:30 p.m.
- Attend the **REQUIRED** performance on Wednesday, April 29th at 6:00 p.m.
- Memorizing not only their part, but where it happens in the song and or in the program.

WHAT ARE THE SPECIAL PARTS?

Solos are in, “The Fruit of the Spirit”, “The Peace of God”, “He Gives Me Joy” & “Wait for the Lord”.

Speaking Parts (Choose one verse to recite by memory with expression)

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control; against such things there is no law.” Galatians 5:22-23

“I am the vine. You are the branches. If you remain joined to me, and I to you, you will bear a lot of fruit. You can’t do anything without me.” John 15:5

“If you don’t remain joined to me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and dries up. Branches like those are picked up. They are thrown into the fire and burned.” John 15:6

“If you remain joined to me and my words remain in you, ask for anything you wish. And it will be done for you.” John 15:7

“Jesus said: When you bear a lot of fruit, it brings glory to my Father. It shows that you are my disciples.” John 15:8

*Additional narration will be added. Children interested in a narration part or scripture verse should audition with one of these verses.

When we choose solos, we look for the best fit for each part. Since this is the last KidsPraise program for our 5th graders, if two kids do equally well, a 5th grader may be chosen. This doesn’t mean every 5th grader will have a solo, but it helps us honor this special moment for them.
